For USAIHC purposes, driving while under the influence, driving on a suspended license, reckless driving, leaving the scene of an accident, and vehicular homicide are not minor traffic violations and must be declared (whether the result is a ticket or a more severe penalty). Minor traffic violations that result in tickets do not need to be declared. Answering yes to this question does not automatically disqualify you to volunteer; however, information obtained from the background check will be used in the review process.)*
